# Arboretum Pre-Inspection

## Check List

1. Local expert(s) have helped to identify the trees.
2. Hazardous hanging and large dead limbs have been removed from arboretum trees and nearby trees.
3. Trees are in good health and are/will be pruned to encourage health.
4. Trees are protected from string trimmer damage and mowers (through communication with maintenance, markings, mulch or protection device).
5. Mulch, if used, does not touch the tree trunks and isn't deeper than 3 inches.
6. Newly planted trees have a watering schedule.
7. All trees are labeled with Scientific and Common Names.
8. Tree labels are easy to locate and read.
9. A map is available for all Level 2-4 arboreta.
10. All paperwork and fees have been submitted.
